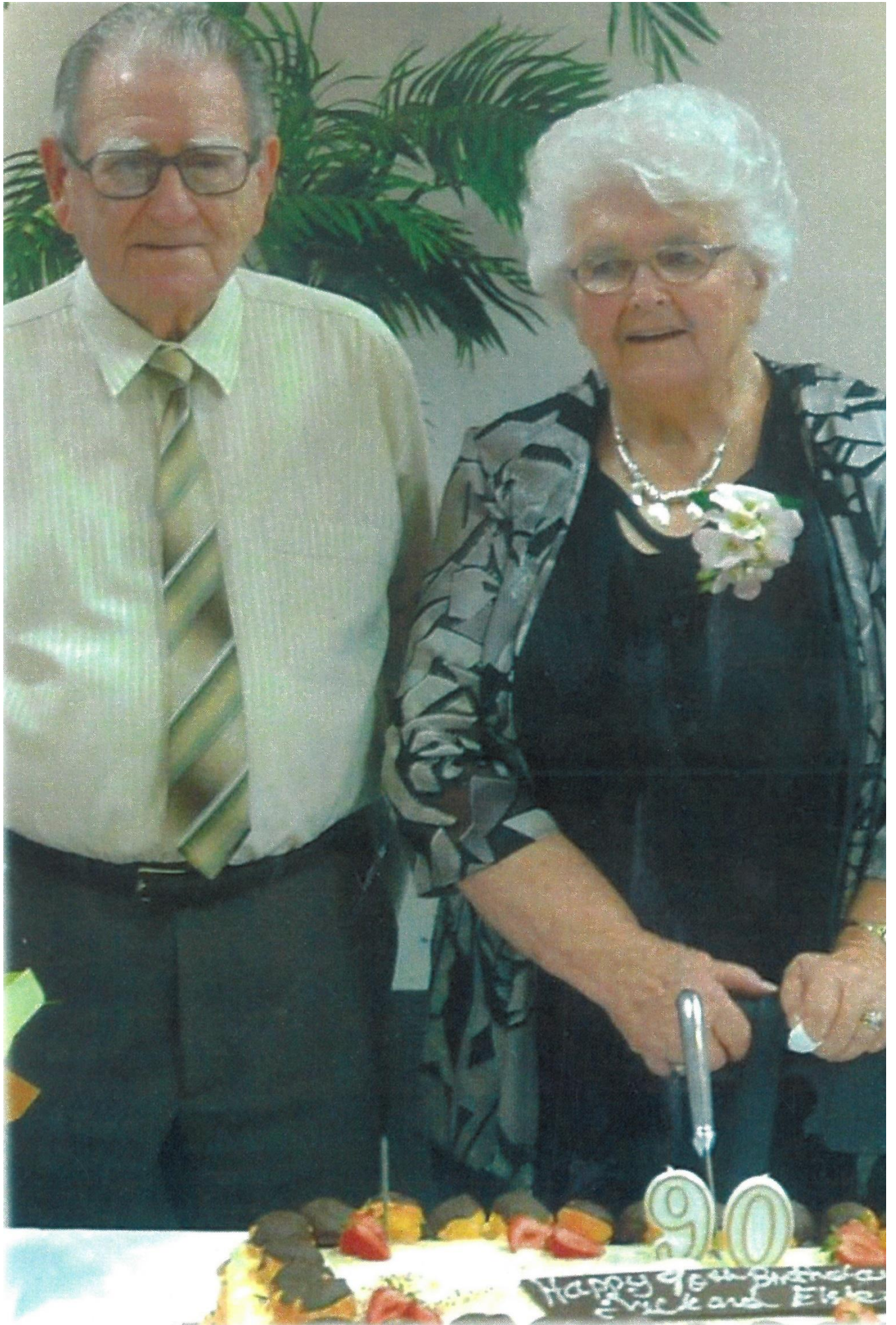

The caring and joy you gave us.*

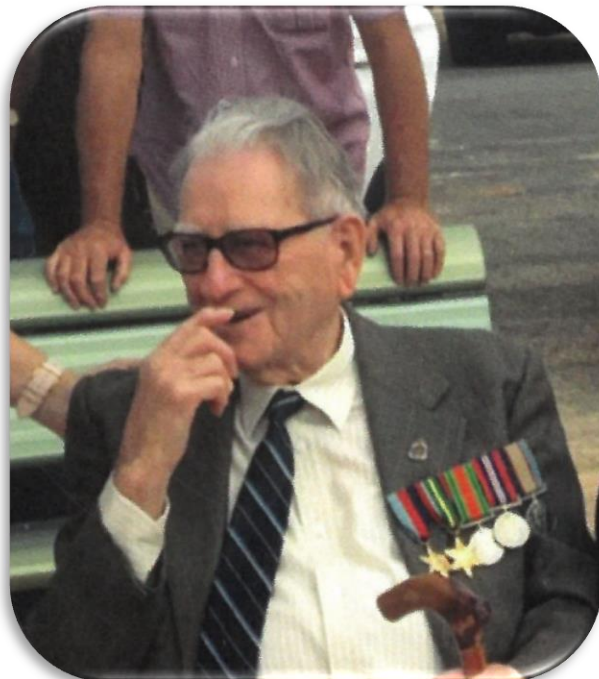
*The rose flower is for our love.

A step on the road to home.*



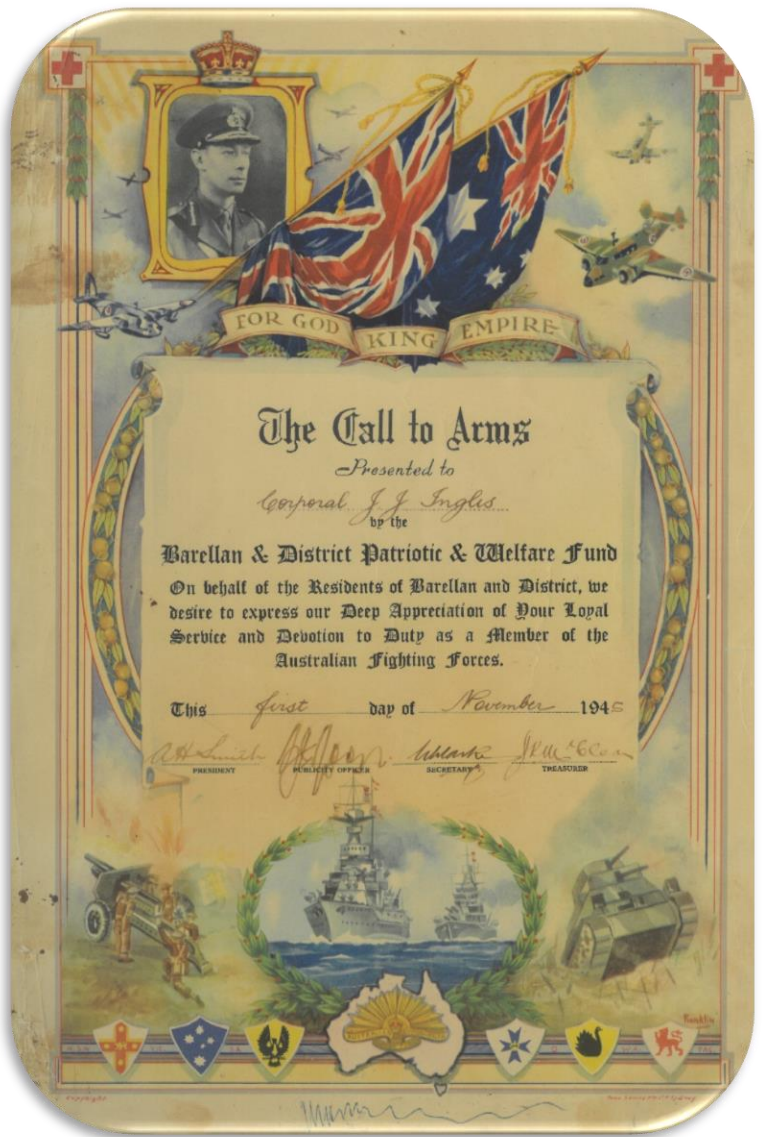


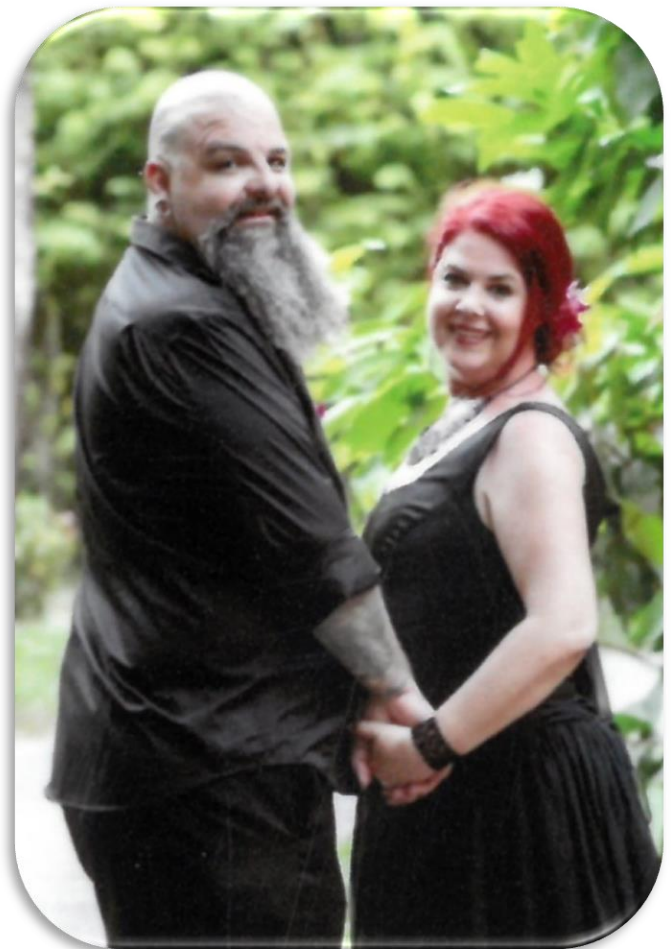
## The Lords Prayer

Amen*

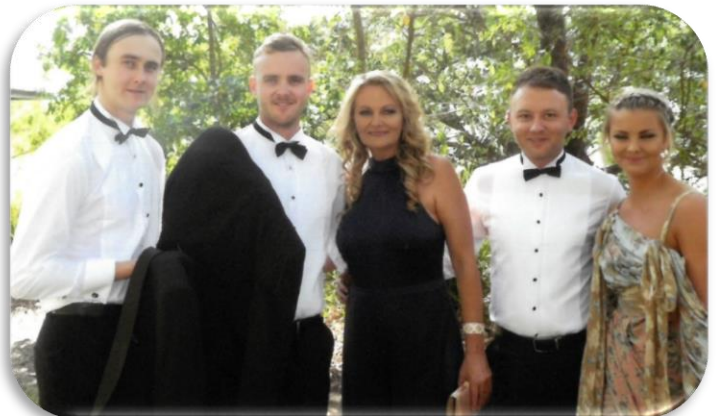
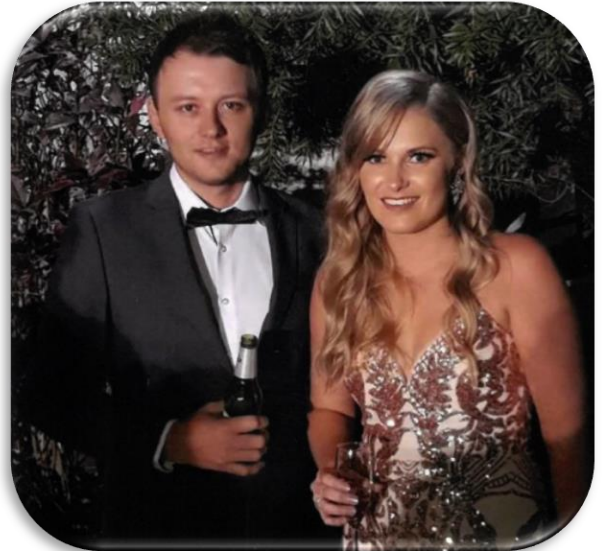
