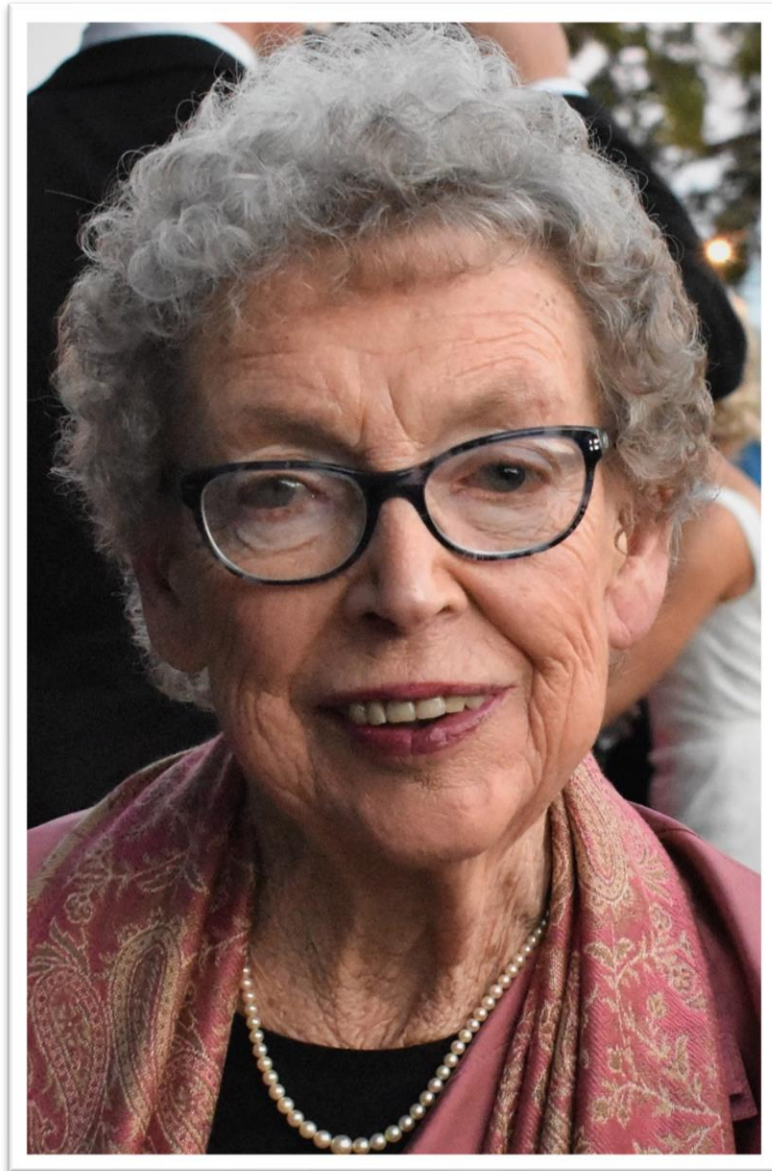

through Jesus Christ our Lord.

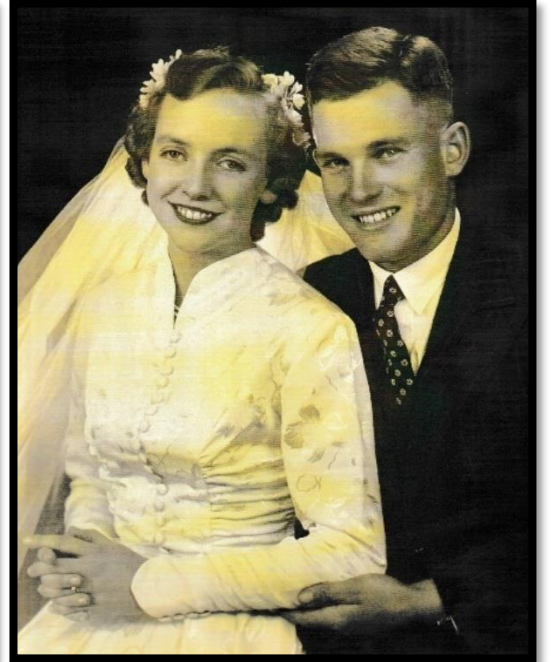

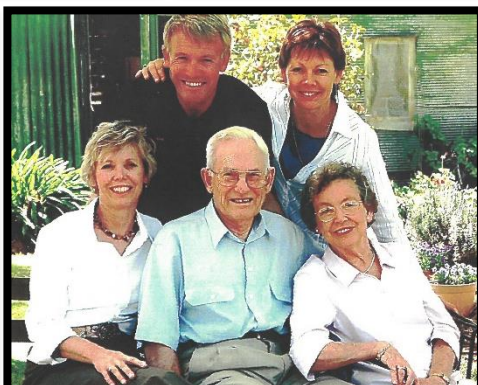
Psalm 23

Praise the everlasting king.

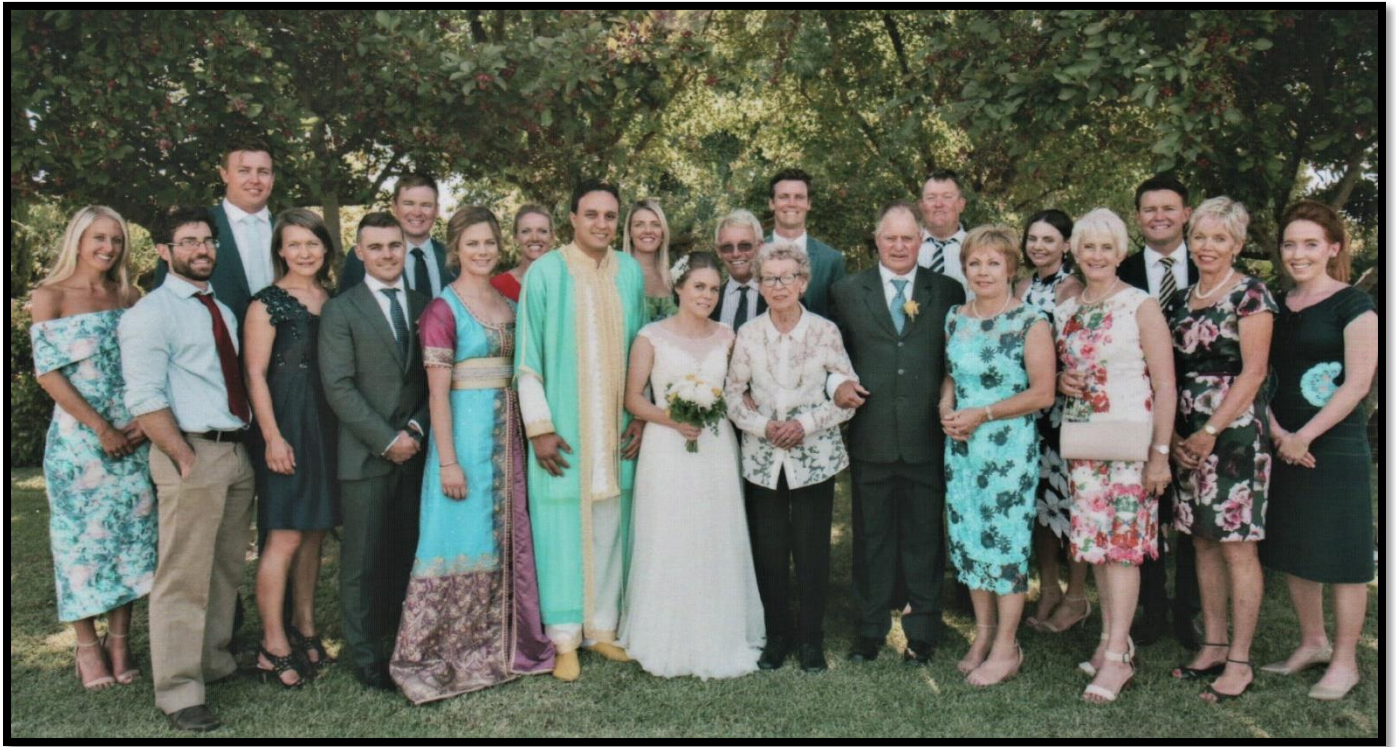
2. Praise him for his grace and favour
